- 2. Non-functional locking pin
- 3. Tyres not in good condition (Canvas/ wire showing, visible thread, visible under inflation)
- 4. Any sign of excessive fluid leaks (Truck refers to constant flow of fluid)
- 5. Load is not secure/ obscures view of driver/ does not comply with size and width guidelines
- 6. Obvious signs of a structurally defective trailer (crack on main beam, trailer twisted, landing gear damaged)
- 7. No headlights (applies for night operations)
