INCLEMENT WEATHER AFFECTING TRINIDAD & TOBAGO

Inclement weather conditions continue to affect Tobago and northern Trinidad. Heavy showers and thundershowers could develop which may last for the next 6 to 10 hours. Rainfall accumulations could be in excess of 50 mm in some areas, particularly Tobago and northern parts of Trinidad. This activity is related to local dynamics in a moist and unstable atmosphere.

Gusty winds can accompany showers and thundershowers. Localized street/flash flooding is likely in heavy or prolonged downpours and landslips/landslides may occur in areas so prone. Gradual improvement is expected towards the afternoon.

Citizens are advised to be vigilant and cautious as they conduct their activities and to pay attention to the media or visit our website at www.metoffice.gov.tt/forecast for daily weather updates at 6am, 10am, 3pm and 6pm.

AT THIS TIME, WE UNDERScore TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO IS NOT UNDER ANY TROPICAL STORM THREAT, WATCH OR WARNING.

The Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service will continue to closely monitor this weather event and will issue another bulletin if the situation warrants.
