



NOTICE #03-2016: Importation of Dangerous Cargo Containers – IMO Class 1.4 or UNDG #0012

January 8th, 2016

Please be reminded of the following guidelines that will assist in maintaining a high level of safety and security, when importing Dangerous Cargo containers (IMO Class 1.4 or UNDG #0012) at the Port of Point Lisas:

- 1) The Shipping Agent must advise our Port Management team, at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the vessel's arrival, of the container(s) to be imported. Our Port Management Team comprises:

- 2) All statutory clearance (*Security, Customs & Excise, etc.*) must be attained prior to the vessel's arrival.
- 3) Immediately upon discharge of the Dangerous Cargo container(s), the Shipping Agent/Consignee must take direct delivery of the container(s).
- 4) Dangerous Cargo containers must be escorted off the Port of Point Lisas by authorities from the Police and Fire Services.
