



NOTICE 05-2016: Corrective Repairs to Gantry Crane Rails on Berth #5, Port Point Lisas

January 26th, 2016

Following the recent replacement of the Gantry Crane Rails on Berth #5 at the Port of Point Lisas, it has become necessary to perform corrective works as a result of some minor defects identified. These repairs are scheduled to take place during the period **February 15th to 18th, 2016**.

Because of the short time frame the impact on vessel productivity will be minimal as both gantry cranes will be operational and vessels will be safely berthed with a small overhang to the south toward Berth #4.
