



NOTICE 10-2016: Procedure for Tugs and Workboats to utilize PLIPDECO's berths - Port Point Lisas

March 4th, 2016

Please be reminded of the following procedure for allowing Tugs and Workboats to utilize PLIPDECO's berths for the purpose of conducting business related operations.

- 1) A request must be made by the Captain of the Tug/Workboat to PLIPDECO's Harbour & Marine Department on Channel 16 (call sign "PLIPDECO Marine") seeking permission to come alongside.
- 2) The Captain must indicate to the Harbour & Marine department the purpose of the visit, duration of stay and estimated time of departure.
- 3) Based on requirements and availability, a berth will be assigned accordingly to conduct the operations.

This update has become necessary to ensure that a high level of safety/security is maintained for all users of the marine environment at the Port of Point Lisas. Strict adherence to the procedure is advisable as non-conformance may result in vessels being denied a berthing space.
