



## NOTICE 29-2016: Traffic Detour in the vicinity of Shell Trinidad Limited and Weighbridge on Atlantic Avenue

July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016

Please be advised that emergency excavation works on Atlantic Avenue, in the vicinity of Shell Trinidad Limited and the Weighbridge, will commence on **Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2016** from 7:00 a.m. to approximately 7:00 p.m. The repair is estimated to be completed within one (1) day.

This emergency work is required to repair a failure in the roadway at this vicinity. To ensure the safety of commuters, temporary arrangements for entry/exit to the Port of Point Lisas will be DETOURED as follows:

- All Traffic entering the Port will keep LEFT and use the 80 metres bypass gravel roadway provided and then return unto the normal roadway.
- All Traffic exiting the Port will keep RIGHT unto the said 80 metres gravel roadway and then proceed back unto the normal roadway.

The above will not affect traffic entering and exiting the Port in any way as PLIPDECO's Security Officers will be onsite to assist with traffic regulation. Commuters are advised to observe the signage, follow all traffic directives, reduce speed and proceed with caution in this area.
