



NOTICE 48-2016: 12-HOUR CUT-OFF TIME FOR RECEIVING FULL EXPORT CONTAINERS AT THE PORT OF POINT LISAS

October 31st, 2016

Based on the recent launch of the NAVIS N4 Upgrade at the Port of Point Lisas, the Port will be implementing additional measures to compliment this system.

Please be advised that a **12-Hour Cut-Off time for receiving FULL EXPORT Containers** at the Port, prior to the Estimated Time of Arrival (ETA) of the vessel will be implemented on **Monday 14th November, 2016**.

Also, please be reminded that the allowable time for the submission of vessel's documentation, such as Discharge/Load Lists and Plans, is 16 hours prior to the vessel's ETA at the Port. The exception will be Short Sea vessel calls which will have an allowable time of 8 hours for document submission.
