A WARM EVENING WILL GIVE WAY TO A COOL AND CLEAR NIGHT.

TUESDAY 12^H – (CODE **BLUE**)

A PREDOMINANTLY SUNNY DAY DESPITE THE CHANCE OF THE ODD SHOWER FAVOURING HILLY AREAS. THE NIGHT WILL BE COOL AND CLEAR.

SYNOPSIS: RELATIVELY DRY AND STABLE ATMOSPHERE

WEDNESDAY 13TH – (CODE **BLUE**)

A PREDOMINANTLY SUNNY DAY DESPITE THE CHANCE OF THE ODD SHOWER FAVOURING HILLY AREAS. THE NIGHT WILL BE COOL AND CLEAR.

SYNOPSIS: RELATIVELY DRY AND STABLE ATMOSPHERE

THURSDAY 14TH – (CODE **BLUE**)

SUNNY CONDITIONS INTERSPERSED WITH SOME CLOUDY PERIODS AND FEW DAYTIME SHOWERS. THE NIGHT WILL BE COOL AND CLEAR.

SYNOPSIS: INCREASE IN LOW LEVEL MOISTURE ASSOCIATED WITH LOW LEVEL TROUGH

**N.B. : INFORMATION BULLETIN IN EFFECT – LONG PERIOD SWELLS TO AFFECT COASTLINES
ESPECIALLY NORTH COAST OF TRINIDAD AND SHELTERED COASTS OF TOBAGO**

Status Code:

BLUE: NO SIGNIFICANT WEATHER FEATURES (PROBABILITY < 25%)

GREEN: LOW POTENTIAL OF SIGNIFICANT WEATHER (PROBABILITY 25% - 40%)

ORANGE: MEDIUM POTENTIAL OF SIGNIFICANT (SEVERE) WEATHER (PROBABILITY 41% - 70%)

RED: HIGH POTENTIAL OF SIGNIFICANT OR SEVERE WEATHER (PROBABILITY >70%)
