



NOTICE 23-2018: DELAYS AT THE PORT OF POINT LISAS DUE TO SEA SWELLS

October 1st, 2018

This notice serves to confirm that as at September 29th, 2018 at approximately 1500 hours, the Point Lisas Harbour was affected by heavy sea swells. As a result, vessels alongside the Berths and Savonetta Piers were required to vacate to anchorage as a matter of safety.

The Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service (TTMS) has since issued an advisory on September 30th, 2018 that the existing conditions will continue throughout the weekend and dissipate by approximately 0600 hours on October 2nd 2018.

In an effort to facilitate our valued Port Users and for transparency, vessels will be accommodated once the advisory is lifted on a first arrival basis.
