



## NOTICE 28-2019: DELAYS AT THE PORT OF POINT LISAS DUE TO SEA SWELLS

October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019

This notice serves to confirm that as at October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at approximately 0300 hours, the Point Lisas Harbour was affected by heavy sea swells. As a result, vessels alongside the Terminal Berths and Savonetta Piers were adversely affected and cargo operations were delayed.

The Trinidad and Tobago Meteorological Service (TTMS) issued an advisory on October, 28<sup>th</sup> 2019 that the existing conditions should dissipate by 0600 hours on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019.

In an effort to facilitate our valued Port Users and for transparency, vessels will be accommodated once the advisory is lifted on a first arrival basis.
