



NOTICE 27-2020: UTILISATION OF THE FLUKE 568 IR THERMOMETER AT PLIPDECO HOUSE AND THE CONTAINER EXAMINATION STATION (CES)

May 20th, 2020

In response to the increasing developments regarding COVID-19 (Coronavirus) cases reported in Trinidad and Tobago, the Corporation wishes to advise that effective **May 21st, 2020**, Security Personnel stationed at PLIPDECO House and at the Container Examination Station (C.E.S), will be using the **Fluke 568 IR Thermometer** to ascertain the temperature of all employees and stakeholders accessing these Facilities.

As such, the following steps will be implemented upon arrival at the location mentioned above:

STEP	DETAILS
Step 1	The employee and/ or stakeholder present himself/herself at the designated area.
Step 2	The Security Personnel gently points the IR Thermometer towards the employee's and/ or stakeholder's neck (leaving a 3 - 4 feet social gap). Do note that no skin contact will be made in the testing process.
Step 3	The temperature reading will display in approximately two (2) seconds.
Step 4	Any person exhibiting flu- like symptoms or having a temperature of thirty-eight (38) degrees Celsius or higher will be denied entry to the facility and IMMEDIATELY referred to the Health, Safety and Environment Department.

The health and safety of all employees and stakeholders continue to be of utmost importance to the Corporation and as new developments arise with the COVID-19 virus, we will continue to adopt relevant methods in keeping with the guidance issued by the Government of Trinidad and Tobago.
