

NOTICE 41-2020: CUSTOMS APPROVAL – GATE PASS/SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS FOR THE DELIVERY OF FULL IMPORT CONTAINERS

September 14th, 2020

Please be advised that effective **September 7th**, **2020**, once authorization is received from Customs & Excise for the delivery of <u>full import containers</u> and the necessary approvals are stamped on the following documentation, these documents will be valid for a period of Five (5) working days for consignees/customers who are part of Customs and Excise Voluntary Compliance Programme (VCP) and three (3) working days for all other consignees/customers respectively:

- 1. Gate Passes
- 2. Bills of Lading (B/Ls)
- 3. C87
- 4. Customs Release Orders

As such, Consignee Clerks and Brokers will not be required to return to the Port's Delivery Office to obtain a new Gate Pass each day or to Customs and Excise Office at the Port to have B/Ls, C87 Release Orders re-stamped after the initial delivery processing has been initiated, within the above mentioned time periods.

Kindly note that <u>all other authorisation remain in effect</u> and must be validated prior to processing. These include:

- 1. Shipping Agents Releases
- 2. Demurrage and Detention Releases/Charges
- 3. Reefer/Electricity charges
- 4. Any other related charges
