



## **NOTICE 06 - 2021: Submission of Vessel Documentation for General/Break Bulk Cargo**

March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021

Please note that the established procedure for Containerized Cargo remains unchanged as per PLIPDECO's Notice 12-2019.

However, in an effort to further ensure that the Port of Point Lisas maintains quality service to our customers, please note the following updates regarding the submission of vessel documentation for General/Break Bulk Cargo:

### **General/Break Bulk Cargo:**

The amended procedure will become effective **March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021**. The following are to be submitted via e-mail to PLIPDECO's Cargo Handling Department no later than 16 hours prior to the arrival of the respective vessel:

1. Load Lists/Plans for Export Break Bulk Cargo and Cargo Manifests, Discharge Cargo Listing and Vessel Stow Plans for Import Break Bulk Cargo
2. Shippers and their respective Shipping Agencies are advised that the Authorization for Entry Letters for Export Break Bulk Cargo must be delivered by hand or sent via e-mail to PLIPDECO's Cargo Handling Department no later than 24 hours prior to the arrival of the respective vessel and prior to the arrival of the cargo at the Port's In-Gate.

Please be reminded that charges will be applicable as per the Port Tariff for Port of Point Lisas for the late submission of the documentation stated above.
