



NOTICE 14 -2021: Operations at PLIPDECO's LCL Warehouse effective Monday, April 26th, 2021

In light of the recent measures implemented by the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago at the Post Cabinet Media Briefing on Wednesday, April 21st, 2021 to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus, please note the following arrangements at the LCL Warehouse effective **Monday, April 26th, 2021**.

- **The Customs and Excise Division will be attending to twenty-five (25) Non-Trade Appointments and twenty-five (25) Trade Customers per day.**
- All NVOCCs are therefore required to utilize the LCL Warehouse Appointment System which will facilitate a total of twenty-five (25) appointments on a daily basis.

Additionally, we will like to take this opportunity to remind you of the following requirements:

- Masks must be worn to gain entry to the facility and must remain on at all times.
- Infrared Thermometer testing will be conducted at the Security booth before entering the compound.
- Sanitisation stations are provided for customers: *upon entry at the Security Booth and on entering the Customs Examination area.*
- Customers are required to practice social distancing of 2 meters (6 ft.).
- Customers exhibiting flu-like symptoms (coughing, fever and sneezing) would not be allowed to enter the facility.

We thank you for your understanding and cooperation in this matter and encourage you to take the necessary precautions to prevent the spread of the virus.
