



## **NOTICE 24 -2021: Reminder: Wearing of Masks and Mandatory Use of PPE**

May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021

As we seek to ensure the safety of all stakeholders during the Pandemic, it has been observed that a number of truck drivers have not been complying with the requirement to keep masks on at all times while on the Port.

Please be reminded that PLIPDECO has implemented a zero tolerance approach for non-compliance with this requirement. As a result, any driver who is not in adherence with this guideline shall have his transaction cancelled and be required to leave the Port.

Drivers are also reminded of the other established guidelines that need to be followed at all times:

1. If a truck driver exits his truck he must be in full PPE (steel-tip boots, reflective vest, hard hat).
2. During cargo discharge or loading, the driver must either remain inside his truck or if he chooses to exit must remain in close proximity to the truck.
3. In the performance of any other transaction, the driver must move only from the truck to the point of the transaction and vice versa. There should be no movement to any other part of the Port or congregating.
4. Truck drivers are prohibited from stopping, waiting or parking on the Port unless it's for the purpose of conducting a specific transaction.

Your cooperation in the relation to the preceding is requested, as we work collectively to make the facility safer for all stakeholders during these challenging times.
