



NOTICE 06 - 2022: UTILIZATION OF METAL DETECTORS AT PLIPDECO's FACILITIES

Reference is made to the captioned subject. The Point Lisas Industrial Port Development Corporation Limited (PLIPDECO) continues to prioritize the safety and security of its employees, stakeholders and port users by maintaining strong and effective access controls. Therefore, the Corporation wishes to advise all personnel of the re-instatement of mandatory metal detection searches when entering ALL PLIPDECO facilities, effective **Wednesday February 16th 2022.**

PLIPDECO is responsible for implementing security measures to mitigate risks to all our stakeholders and assets. It is a non-invasive process and maintains the current social distancing requirements. The Officers stationed at the security checkpoint are mandated to search all persons entering and exiting the facility at any point in time. If you are in possession of any items that can and may trigger the detector you are required to declare such to the Officer as well as the nature of the items.

Any person refusing to present himself/herself for such screening may result in denial of entry.

We kindly ask all personnel to cooperate with the Security Officers to ensure a smooth flow of traffic and transition between each person entering and exiting the facilities.
