



## NOTICE NO 14-2022: ROAD REPAIRS ALONG PACIFIC AVENUE, CASPIAN DRIVE AND ATLANTIC AVENUE ON THE POINT LISAS INDUSTRIAL ESTATE

The Point Lisas Industrial Port Development Corporation Limited (PLIPDECO) has engaged the services of Danny's Enterprises Company Limited to conduct the repaving of roadways along **Pacific Avenue**, **Caspian Drive** and **Atlantic Avenue** on the Point Lisas Industrial Estate.

This project will commence on **Saturday May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022** and is estimated to be completed on **Sunday June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022**. **Please be guided by the following work days, times and traffic arrangements for the various locations:**

| When works are being conducted south of the Couva River, access and egress to and from Caspian Drive will be via Carli Bay Road and Waterloo Road to the north. Please be further guided by the personnel directing traffic on site.  |  |                    |
| When works are being conducted north of the Couva River, access and egress to and from Caspian Drive south will be via Carli Bay Road and Atlantic Avenue. The barrier at Waterloo Road to the north will also remain open as an alternative route for tenants on Caspian Drive north. Please be further guided by the personnel directing traffic on site. |  |                    |

| <b>Atlantic Avenue</b>  | May 28 <sup>th</sup> , 29 <sup>th</sup> , June 4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> | 7.00 am to 7.00 pm |
| The Estate entrance/exit barriers on Caribbean Drive, Caspian Drive and Pacific Avenue Extension will remain open during the time stipulated. Any one of the above mentioned barriers may be temporarily closed in order to redirect traffic away from an active work area. 2. In case of an emergency, PLPDECO will coordinate with the Contractor and the roadway may be temporarily opened for unrestricted flow. This will be coordinated with the Emergency Response Personnel, including but not limited to TEMAS, PLIPDECO's Security, the Couva Police as well as the Regional Corporation.
3. Any wide, heavy or high loads will only be accommodated into and out of the Estate once PLIPDECO is given 48 hours' notice of same prior to movement.

6. Access to Atlantic Plaza main entrance via the BC Roundabout will not be affected during the proposed works
7. It is recommended that alternative routes (Phoenix Park Road, Caspian Drive, Caribbean Drive and Pacific Avenue Extension) be used to access the Estate if it is not necessary for you to traverse via Atlantic Avenue during the project.
