



NOTICE 48-2022: Temporary Interruption of Electricity Supply at the Port of Point Lisas on Sunday, December 18th, 2022

Please be advised that the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission (T&TEC) is scheduled to replace electricity poles at the Port of Point Lisas.

The exercise is scheduled to commence on **Sunday, December 18th, 2022** during the hours of **0700** hours to **1200** hours and will therefore result in a temporary interruption of the electricity supply to the following locations:

- **All Offices and Accommodations from the Weighbridge to the Port of Point Lisas (excluding the Port Administration Building which will be on a back-up supply)**
- **All tenants/Port Users located at the Port of Point Lisas (including Arawak Trinidad Limited, Savonetta Piers (National Energy) and Ventrin Petroleum Company Limited)**
