



**NOTICE 02-2023: Temporary Interruption of Electricity Supply on the Point Lisas Industrial Estate and the Port of Point Lisas on Sunday January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 from 0800 hours to 1500 hours**

January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023

Please be advised that the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission (T&TEC) is scheduled to replace an electricity pole along Caspian Drive on the Point Lisas Industrial Estate. The exercise is carded for **Sunday January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023** from approximately **0800** hours to **1500** hours, and will therefore result in a temporary disruption of electricity supply to the following locations:

**Port of Point Lisas:**

- All Offices and Accommodations from the Weighbridge to the Port of Point Lisas (excluding the Port Administration Building which will be on a back-up supply)
- All tenants/Port Users located at the Port of Point Lisas (including Arawak Trinidad Limited, Savonetta Piers (National Energy) and Ventrin Petroleum Company Limited)

**Point Lisas Industrial Estate:**

- Most of the companies on the Industrial Estate

Please note that PLIPDECO House, First Citizens Bank, the National Gas Company, Atlantic Plaza, Subway and KFC WILL NOT BE AFFECTED by this outage.
