to and from the ship using shore cranes or ship's gear

"MOVE" The activity to get general cargo/containerized cargo from one location to

"RO/RO" Roll On/Roll Off: a feature in ships where ramps are lowered to the docks

or quay so forklifts and other vehicles can drive into the belly of the ship,

rather than be lifted aboard

"TEU" Twenty-foot Equivalent Unit: a measurement of shipping volume
