

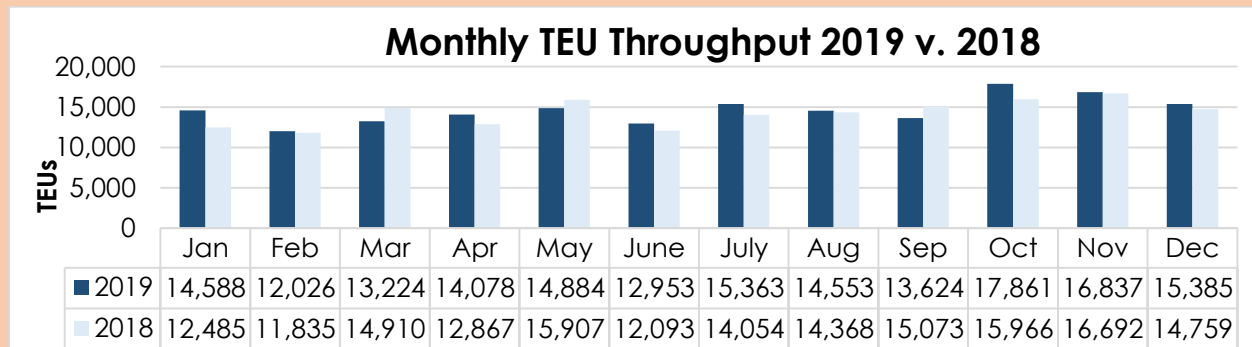


# Performance at the Port of Point Lisas

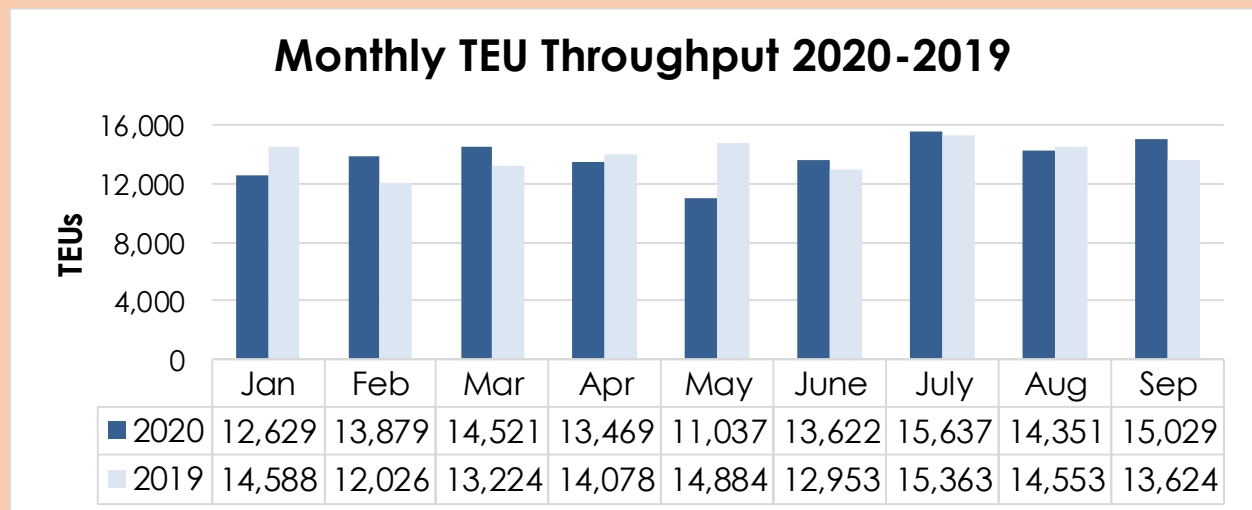


## Containerised Cargo

The Port of Point Lisas handled a total of 175,376 TEUs in 2019 compared to 170,951 TEUs for the same period in 2018, a 3% increase overall. Exports increased by 6%, Imports increased by 3% and Transhipment decreased by 15%.



For the period January 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020, the Port handled 124,174 TEUS, compared to 125,293 TEUS for the same period in 2019, a 0.89% decrease overall.





# Performance at the Port of Point Lisas



## General Cargo

General Cargo tonnage handled at the Port of Point Lisas was 348,052 tonnes in 2019, compared to 371,954 in 2018, resulting in a decrease by 6.4% overall. This reduction in general cargo tonnage for 2019 was attributable to reductions in the categories for bulk, lumber/plywood, pallets, boxes and vehicle and equipment.

For the period January 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020, the Port handled XXXXX tonnes, compared to XXXXXX tonnes for the same period in 2019, a XXX% decrease overall.

Average net containerised productivity YTD for September was 28 moves per hour, compared to 30 moves per hour for the same period in 2019. Gross productivity which is a measure of productivity inclusive of delays was 21 moves per hour to date compared to 22 moves per hour as at September 2019.
