



Infrastructural Upgrades on the Point Lisas Industrial Estate



PLIPDECO's mandate as landlord of the Point Lisas Industrial Estate involves the maintenance of the basic infrastructure including roadways, drainage and the installation of lighting. In keeping with this obligation, several initiatives were undertaken in the latter part of 2018.

In terms of roadworks, several roads were repaired/repaved on the Industrial Estate including areas along Atlantic Avenue, Pacific Avenue and Caspian Drive. This work began in April 2018 and was performed over a 7-month period, and completed in November 2018.

Another project involved conducting drainage works at two sites along Pacific Avenue. This work was necessary to alleviate flooding on Pacific Avenue and provide a better water flow.

In addition, to improving the safety and security of users on the Industrial Estate, a Street Lighting project is on-going and is currently in Phase 3 of the project. Lighting is being installed along Caribbean Drive and Maracaibo Drive and is expected to be completed by the end of March 2019. The first phase was completed in 2016 and advanced to the 2nd phase in 2017 with lighting being installed along Atlantic Avenue, Caribbean Drive, Amazon Drive and Caspian Drive.
