

# 52<sup>nd</sup> Annual Meeting of Shareholders

On June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 the Corporation hosted its 52<sup>nd</sup> Annual General Meeting at the Conference Centre, PLIPDECO House. In his presentation, PLIPDECO's President, Ashley Taylor highlighted the Corporation's accomplishments for 2018. Some of these accomplishments/highlights include:

- The deployment of the two scanners at the Port of Point Lisas by the Customs and Excise Division;
- The Corporation's upgrade to ISO 9001:2015 standard as part of its system of continuous improvement to its Quality Management Process;
- The re-affirmation of an A+ rating by CariCRIS for the 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive year;
- Launching of a Labour Call-Out System for casual terminal clerks thereby streamlining the process of selection and deployment of labour;
- Development of a Container Control Portal to provide dynamic access to the status of containers on and off the Port. A pilot was successfully launched to one of the largest customers;
- The completion of Berth 3 rehabilitation and the return to operations in July, thus providing a boost to berth availability;
- Construction of offices for Customs and Hauliers to support the scanning of containers;
- Other infrastructural works focussed on the Port and Industrial Estate;
- Procurement and deployment of 12 new forklifts at the Warehouse and Port; and
- Commissioning of an additional Reach Stacker into operations.



Some of the projections/milestones for 2019 include: the new Port Tariff which was implemented on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019; NAVIS upgrade; a General Cargo Management system; new collective bargaining agreements; roll out of a revised performance management system; labour reform; automated labour call-out system; development of a tyre management system; an appointment system at the Warehouse and development of a Haulier database.
