

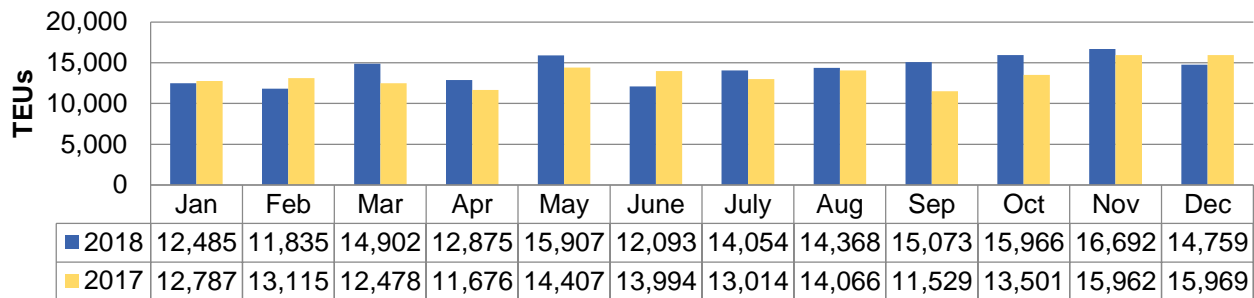

Containerised Cargo

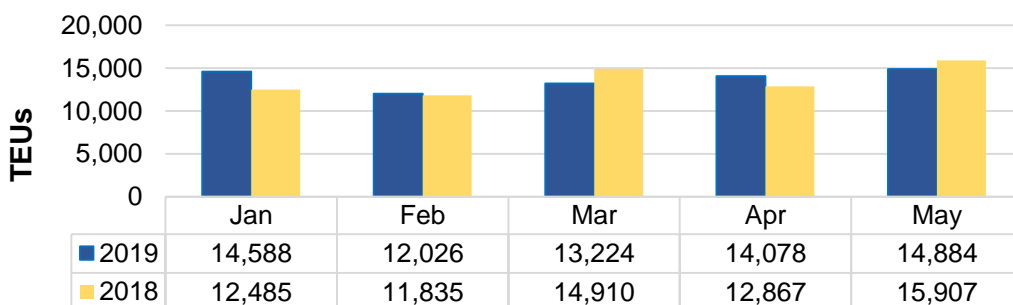
The Port of Point Lisas handled a total of 170,951 TEUs in 2018 compared to 162,498 TEUs for the same period in 2017, a 5.2% increase overall. Exports increased by 5.7%, Imports increased by 4.7% and Transshipment increased by 5.4%.

For the period January 1st to May 31st, 2019, the Port handled 68,800 TEUS, compared to 68,004 TEUS for the same period in 2018, a 1.2% increase overall.

General Cargo

General Cargo tonnage at the Port of Point Lisas rose by 137,467 tonnes in 2018, representing an increase of 58.6% year-over-year. In total, 371,954 tonnes of general cargo were handled in 2018 compared to 234,487 metric tonnes in 2017.

General Cargo YTD December Comparison - 2017 vs 2018 – Metric Tonnes

This significant increase in general cargo tonnage for 2018 was attributable to increases in the categories for bulk, lumber and pallets and boxes. For the period January 1st to May 31st, 2019, the Port handled 172,219 tonnes, compared to 173,580 tonnes for the same period in 2018, a 1% decrease overall.
